

## BREMEN TRAC – COFUND Fellowship program



The University of Bremen, a mid-sized university with approximately 250 professorships and 19,000 students, offers a broad range of disciplines and competes internationally in top-level research. With its ambitious institutional strategy the university was successful in the national Excellence Initiative as one of only eleven universities in Germany.

Funded from the University's own Central Research Development Fund (CRDF) and from the Marie Curie COFUND fellowship program, the University of Bremen offers fellowships for postdoctoral researchers.

## Our offer:

- 2 year incoming fellowship for postdoctoral researchers
- Open to all research areas
- The development and implementation of an independent research project

## Who can apply?

- International postdoctoral researchers (at most two years after having received their doctorate) are encouraged to apply for a two year BREMEN TRAC incoming COFUND Fellowship.
- Applicants can be of any nationality but at the time of application, they must not have resided or carried out their main activity (work, studies, etc.) in Germany for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the call deadline.
