The Conference will be held on 22-26 March 2010, Ukraine, Kyiv.

Conditions:

- In order to apply for participation the one should prepare a paper within listed themes and send theses for the Conference Organizing Committee.
- The working languages are Ukrainian, Russian and English.
- The application file should contain theses of the paper (please, see the requirements below) and filled application form (Profile of participant).
- Digital file format of theses is required (.doc/.docx/.rtf).
- Submission deadline is **22 February 2010**.

Papers that do not match the indicated requirements won't be considered.

The Organizing Committee reserves a right to select papers for the participation in the Conference and to make changes in general conditions.

The participation fee is 100 UAH (10 Euro). This fee should be paid after the paper is accepted (approximately, after 1 March 2010).

Account details for payment will be sent together with the acceptance notification.

Based on the result of the conference best papers will be published in conference proceedings.

Round-trip travel, accommodation and meals expenses are not covered with the participation fee and are in the participants' charge.



The work at the Conference will be held at the next plenary sessions:

- Urgent problems of the Ukrainian home market development under globalization effects;
- Contradictions and opportunities for development of the financial system of Ukraine under the World financial crisis;
- Ways to restore the stability of the banking system in Ukraine;
- Use of modern economic and mathematical methods in the Market Economy;
- Transformations in global economy and anti-crisis strategies of the countries;
- Issues of investment and innovative development management for micro and macro levels;
- History and outlook for the accounting, reporting, analysis and audit development in Ukraine;
- The development of the entrepreneurial activity in Ukraine;
- Economics (the working language is English).

Theses requirements

1	Volume	up to 6000 characters
2	Font	Times New Roman, size 12, line space – 1
3	Margins	left – 3 cm, right – 1,6 cm, top and bottom – 2 cm each
4	Page numbering	at the bottom of each page (in the centre)
5	A title should contain (in the same order)	name and last name of the author, name and last name of the academic advisor, year of study and specialty, higher education establishment name
6	A list of references should be given at the end	approximately 5-6 sources in alphabetical order, Times New Roman font, size 10, references should be also given in the main text in the format of source number, pages, within square brackets only, example: [1, p.12-15]
