





Application Deadline Bucerius/WHU Master of Law and Business – Joachim Herz Program: March 31

Hamburg, February 18, 2010

The application deadline for the one-year, English-taught and interdisciplinary Bucerius/WHU Master of Law and Business - Joachim Herz Program ("MLB Program") in Hamburg is March 31, 2010. The next academic year starts on August 23, 2010 with preliminary mathematics and legal courses.

The MLB Program is jointly offered by two of Germany's renowned universities, Bucerius Law School and WHU - Otto Beisheim School of Management to give legal and business professionals the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of international business law as well as international management. Complementary law and business courses provide a unique and comparatively-oriented approach to central issues in international business.

In addition to an intensive curriculum, the MLB Program focuses on social and intercultural skills training as well as active career planning. An internship, a course of general studies and the drafting of a master's thesis are also part of the academic year. The faculty consists of lecturers from academia as well as business and legal practitioners from many countries.

Every academic year, some 50 international law and business graduates with prior work experience are enrolled into the MLB Program. Students generally represent more than 25 countries, come from diverse cultures and are qualified lawyers, business people and scientific researchers, and participate in an extraordinary array of activities. Despite – or perhaps because of – this diversity, the students' motivation, enthusiasm and willingness to work together is striking.

There are a number of scholarships available for applicants with different profiles. Currently, partial scholarships are available for highly qualified future managers who are nominated by their employers.
