

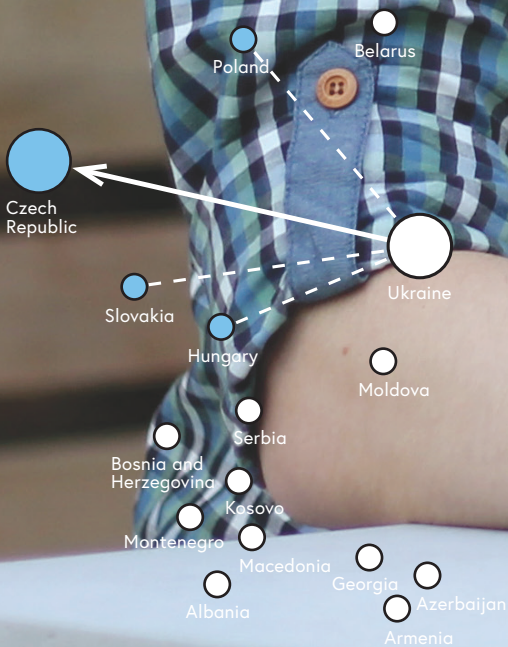

Are you eligible for a scholarship?

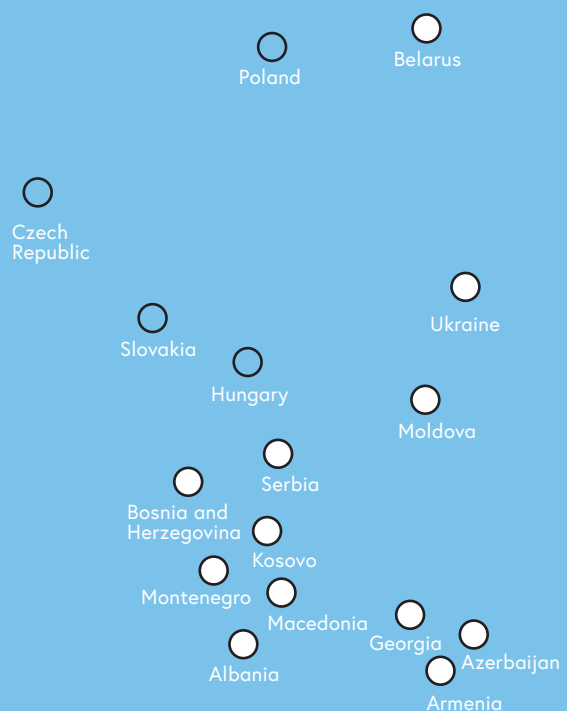
You have to be a citizen of one of the EaP or Western Balkan countries and to have successfully completed at least four semesters of university studies at the time of applying for the scholarship.
