The Viadrina Center B/ORDERS IN MOTION of the European University Frankfurt (Oder) combines and promotes analyses in the social and cultural sciences, business administration and economics as well as law. Its scientific work focuses on processes of demarcating, transcending, overcoming and re-establishing borders, boundaries, frontiers and limits. As a joint project of the university's three faculties, the Center consolidates several main research interests of Viadrina scholars. It aims at fostering academic networks and at augmenting transdisciplinary approaches to Border Studies. With a multitude of international scientific co-operations and the digital research portal B/ORDER STUDIES, the Viadrina Center aspires to establish itself as a major hub for the study of border processes. By funding interdisciplinary projects in the field of "B/Orders in Motion", the European University Viadrina sharpens its profile as a leading research institution.

The Viadrina Center B/ORDERS IN MOTION of the European University Frankfurt (Oder), Germany, invites applications for one fellowship of one up to four months for the period of mid-October 2015 to mid-February 2016

The call for applications addresses highly-qualified, international post-doctoral researchers or professors (incl. Junior or Associate Professors) from the social and cultural studies, business administration and economics or legal sciences who intend to carry out a research project within the main research focus area of the European University Viadrina (EUV) "B/Orders in Motion".

Terms of the fellowship

The fellowship can be awarded for one up to four months (depending on the scope of the research project) and includes:

- A monthly instalment of 1.000 Euro (Junior Fellowship) or 2.000 Euro (Senior fellowship)
- Full assumption of costs for travel and accommodation in Frankfurt (Oder) or Słubice
- Office space at the Viadrina Center B/ORDERS IN MOTION.

The holder of the fellowship is expected to actively participate in the activities of the Viadrina Center B/ORDERS IN MOTION, e.g. by giving a lecture and/ or by conducting a workshop on his/ her research within the scientific field of "B/Orders in Motion". He/ she should contribute to transdisciplinary discussions on questions thematically relevant to the projects hosted under the umbrella of the Center and, in addition, take part in the scientific training of the early stage researchers.

Requested application documents

- A brief letter of motivation (please mention the desired period of time you would like to spend, and the title of a possible lecture, at the Viadrina Center B/ORDERS IN MOTION)
- An outline of the research project within the thematic field of “B/Orders in Motion” (ca. 5-10 pages)
- a curriculum vitae
- A list of publications
- A letter of reference [this applies to applications for the Junior Fellowship only]
