THE EXECUTIVE MASTER OF COMMUNICATION AND EUROPEAN AFFAIRS IS :

- 275 hours of classes and workshops, taking place during the day. Half of the classes are conducted in English, half in French.
- An internship of 3 months with a professional organisation, starting March 2012.
- A Master Thesis supervised.

WE OFFER

- SMALL GROUPS of maximum 25 students, enabling an interactive class environment.
- A PROJECT ORIENTED APPROACH, with focus on student participation and numerous practical assignments.

SCHEDULE
