Summer School on Lawyers' Practical Skills is being conducted at the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University Faculty of Law and is led by the Georgian and US professors from 18 to 29 July, this year.

This Summer School is organized under the partnership between the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University Faculty of Law and the East-West Management Institute's Judicial Independent and Legal Empowerment Project (JILEP) in Georgia, granted by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID).

Twenty students from law faculties of TSU and other accredited high educational institutions participated in it. They have been selected through the open competition by the independent selection commission.

Representatives of partner organizations will assess the outcomes of the summer school and award certificates to the participants during the closing ceremony which will take place at the **Law Faculty library, TSU II building (first floor) at 17:30 pm, July 29, 2011.**
